New Training Programme at Technopark

Technopark is joining hands with the Indian TeX Users Group (TUG India) to launch a programme to train young graduates in running businesses in sophisticated electronic text processing, using TeX.

Technopark and TUG India are inviting applications for the three-month's training programme to be held in Technopark.

Applications are invited from candidates who have a minimum of a Bachelor's science/engineering degree and who are confident of demonstrating a typing speed of at least about 40 words per minute. 15 candidates will be selected based on an aptitude test and a personal interview. Roughly half of the seats are reserved for women.

Apart from exhaustive sessions on TeX technologies and tools, the training programme will also cover subjects in entrepreneurship development and management skills. The aim is to equip participants with the skills needed to ultimately set up small enterprises on their own.

TeX (pronounced "tech") is a programming language and typesetting engine developed and made freely available by Prof. Donald Knuth at Stanford University. TeX is designed for high-quality composition of material that contains a lot of mathematical and technical expressions.

The fee for the entire program is Rs. 1500/- (for 3 months). Upon successful completion of the training, candidates will be awarded certificates jointly by Technopark and TUG India.
